#### Isaiah 43:1-3

43 But now this is what the Lord says, the Lord who created you, O Jacob the Lord who formed you, O Israel. Do not be afraid, because I have redeemed you. I have called you by name. You are mine.

<sup>2</sup> When you cross through the waters, I will be with you. When you cross the rivers, they will not sweep you away. When you walk through fire, you will not be burned, and the flame will not set you on fire.
